

Veterinary Care - overall reasonably healthy breed!

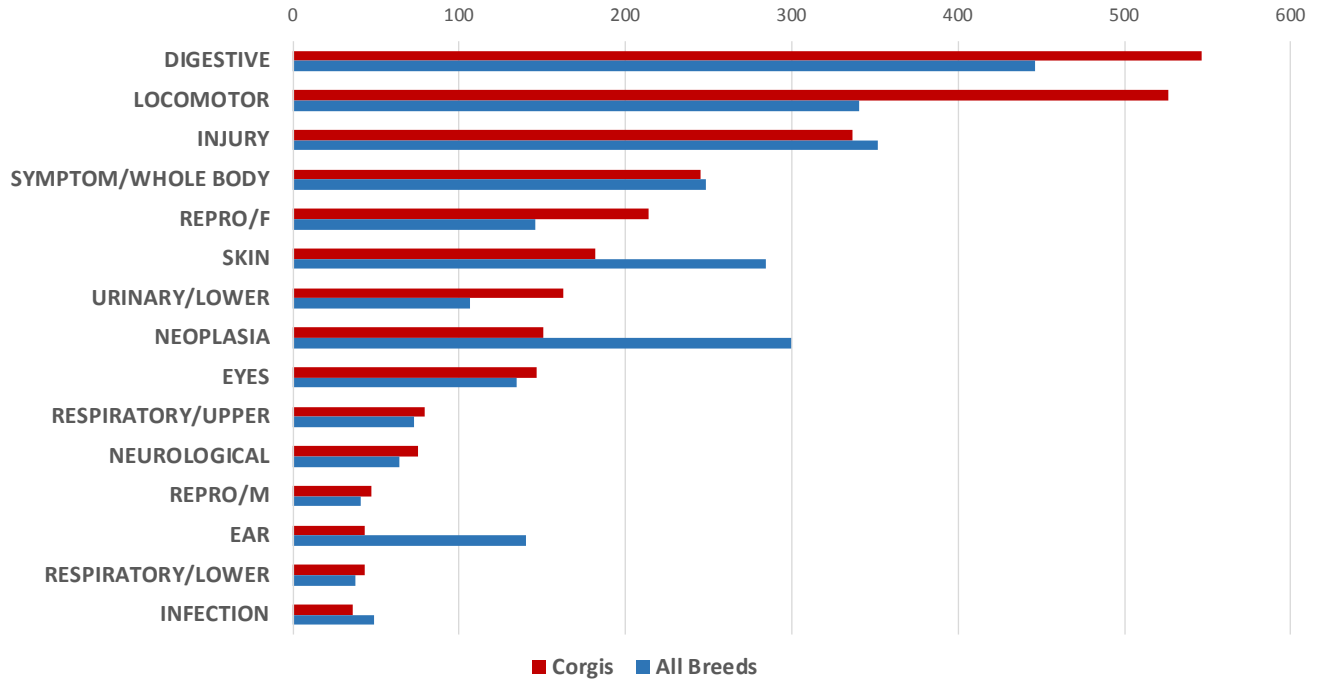
Most Common: Digestive, Locomotor

Highest Risk: Locomotor, Lower urinary tract, cystitis, voiding problems.;

Causes of death - most common and highest risk, Locomotor.

- IMMUNOLOGICAL
- URINARY/UPPER
- BLOOD/VASCULAR
- HEART
- RESPIRATORY/THORACIC
- ENDOCRINE
- CLAW
- DEAD/EUTHANIZED
- BEHAVIOUR
